# **Honor Troupe Criteria**

- 1. Honor Troupe Awards will be divided into three categories: bronze, silver, and gold.
- 2. Troupes will be assessed on current school year (2017-2018). Troupes may use upcoming events for service projects, troupe image boosting projects, productions, and continued education experiences.
- 3. Honor Troupe binders must be submitted at registration at State Festival in January.

## Community/School Service

These projects give back to the community. The troupe will participate in such activities as community food drives, fundraising for not-for-profit organizations, beautification projects, the state philanthropy project etc. These projects can, but do not have to be theatre related.
